Bilcare Research places its first batch of students

■ **PUNE:** Bilcare Research, a provider to clinical services to pharmaceutical companies announced the placement of the first batch of clinical research program of the Bilcare Research Academy. 32 of its 48 students have been placed with companies like Sanofi-Synthelabo (India) Quintiles Technologies (India), Amgen Technology, Chiltern, ICON, Clinical Re-search India, Lupin (Research Park), Serum Institute of India and SIRO Clinpharm, a company statement said. Santosh Hegde, president of Bilcare's Clinical Research Service, said, "This is a 12-month program, with 10 months theory and two months internship. Our students have been placed within three weeks from the end of the theory program. Our Bangalore batch will start this year, while we will also expand into Singapore with the admission process starting from August 2008 this year."
