

Non-cloneable IDs for Delhi Police

TO counter the problem of fake ID cards, the Delhi Police has provided non-cloneable IDs to its over 75,000 personnel. The IDs, devised by Bilcare Technology, a division of Pune-based Bilcare, cannot be duplicated and hence ensures authenticity.

Earlier, policemen were issued paper identity cards that were prone to duplication and security breaches.
